<p>Community Information:</p>	<p>I am sorry to have not been able to meet with people in March at my usual drop in surgeries. I was unfortunately I was taken into hospital on the last weekend of February and had emergency surgery, twice, it has taken a while to recover. I am now back though so do keep in touch if you have any concerns or queries you might have and if I have not yet replied please do give me a nudge as I might not have got to all my messages.</p> <p>We have now entered a 'pre-election period' which used to be called 'purdah', starting on 27th March and lasting until 8th May. All Councillors and Council meetings have rules to abide by during this period and local authorities should not publish any publicity on controversial issues or report views or proposals in such a way that identifies them with any individual members or groups of members. Councillors will need to ensure that they do not use any council resources to support election campaigning and that they do not use any council meetings or events as a platform for campaigning. It will be good to have a weekly food bin collection, less smell and according to the BBC, one food caddy of waste produces enough electricity to power an LED light bulb for 24hrs, with one lorry full powering 1,300 showers. Whilst it's better to not have waste at least we know that collecting it is not going to waste! It is a national change, so do get in touch with me if you have any worries on waste.</p>
