I hope I can take part in the October one (there wont be any GCSEs to worry about then).</p> <p>Local Government Restructure, Reform and Devolution Update</p> <p>The Government Consultation is still open until 13th April, although you cannot say you don't want devolution you can let them know what kind of things you want to see improved from devolution and how this new tier of government (Mayoral Authority) will work with the Unitary Councils. I would encourage everyone to go online and complete their view on this if they can https://www.gov.uk/government/consultations/norfolk-and-suffolk-devolution</p> <p>The interim plans for Unitary councils have been sent back to Government in time for 21st March 2025. The government will review returns from all councils, including the County, District and Borough Councils to determine a way forward for Unitary Councils in Norfolk and Suffolk.</p> <p>A full proposal will then be worked out and agreed and sent to Government by 26th September 2025.</p> <p>Meanwhile in Mid Suffolk</p> <p>Lots of initiatives will be coming out this spring and summer following the £80m budget and capital ambition programme Mid Suffolk agreed in February.</p> <p>We want to ensure residents of Mid Suffolk see long term improvements to:-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Sports – this should be coming out in May 2. Local Business - especially our Food and Drink, Farm to Fork sector, again for May 3. Community facilities, like local community buildings, service centres 4. Local Walking and Cycling – more upgrades to paths now we have our designers 5.
